

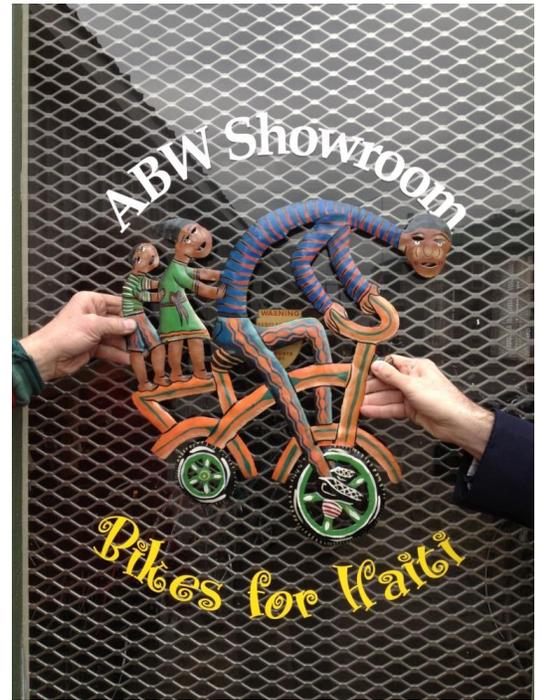


Bikes for Haiti and PIH Canada join forces to support women's health and social justice
